## **Guidelines for Submission of Manuscripts**

Asha Paras International Journal of Gender Studies (APIJGS) ISSN:2583-8687 is a bi-annual (English) and Double-blind peer-reviewed Research Journal of Asha Paras For Peace And Harmony Foundation, India. It carries Research articles, Book views, Opinion pieces and editorial correspondence related to Gender Studies and related disciplines. Editor in Chief/Editor reserves the rights to edit manuscripts and to ensure stylistic consistency.

All material, including notes and references should be typed on one side of the paper (A-4 size) only: double spaced with a wide margin on other sides of the page. Manuscripts should be typed in Times New Roman, 12 points font size. All articles must be accompanied by an abstract of 150-200 words. The typed manuscripts should be of 3000-5000 words. Notes and references should be presented separately at the end of the paper. Notes must contain more than a mere bibliographical reference. With the text the notes should be indicated by superscripts. Contributors must provide their names, affiliations, complete postal and e-mail address with their papers. Articles are to be sent via e-mail. All papers will be Double blind peer-reviewed by a panel of experts before being chosen for publication. Non formatted papers shall not be considered. Plagiarism Report is Mandatory by the author (Maximum up to 10%).

#### d) Articles in Journals

Mehrotra, Nilika. 2004. "Situating Tribal Women", The Eastern Anthropologist, 57(1) 61-73.

Use single quote throughout while quoting sentences or a single word/ phrase, double quotes should be restricted for use with in single quote. Quotation longer than fifty words should be separated from the text and intended with one space with a line space and above and below. In case of italization of words, indigenous local words should be italicized and consistency should be maintained throughout the paper.

**Numerals**: One to nine in words, 10 and above in figures in the written text. However, for exact measurements use only figures (a) distance eg.5 km; (b) age eg.30 years old; (c)percentage eg. 6 percent; (d) centuries eg. 12th century; (e) years eg. 1980s.

**Book Reviews**: Book Reviews on Gender issues should contain name of the author, book reviewed, year of publication, place of publication, publisher, pages and price.
